- (e) if so, the details thereof along with reasons therefor including measures taken to ensure that power generation do not fall as a result of the same?

As per the studies hydro power potential in terms of Installed Capacity of the country is estimated at 148701 MW, out of which 145320 MW of the potential consists of hydro electric schemes having Installed Capacity above 25 MW.
