Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the South Eastern Coalfields Limited (SECL) after Mining of coal in Chhattisgarh undertakes ground levelling work and planation of trees;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the areas where plantation work has been undertaken;
- (c) whether the Government has issued any guidelines to SECL in respect of compliance of environmental conservation rules;
- (d) if so, whether the SECL Management is following these rules and if no, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF COAL, POWER AND NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a): Mine Closure Plans are part of Mining Plans and are mandatory under Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957. Further, approved Environment Management Plans (EMPs) also address the issue of Mine Closure and back filling of mined out areas. As informed by South Eastern Coalfields Limited (SECL) all opencast mines of the company are being backfilled with overburden (OB) in de-coaled areas and plantation is being done on the reclaimed area.

Further, SECL has a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Chhattisgarh Rajya Van Vikas Nigam Limited, Raipur, for carrying out the work of plantation.
