Answer

- (a): There is no separate mechanism to help rural people in acquiring Intellectual Property Rights for indigenous knowhow. However, Traditional Knowledge Digital Library has been created for Indian Systems of Medicine. It provides information on Traditional Knowledge existing in the country, in languages and format understandable by patent examiners at International Patent Offices, so as to prevent the grant of wrong patents.
