(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Bt. Cotton is the only Genetically Modified crop presently allowed for commercial cultivation in the following states of India viz. Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu. No GM food crops has been approved for commercial cultivation in the country till now. Therefore, the question of socioeconomic benefits or adverse effects of such crops does not arise.
