- i) Krishi Unnati Yojanaii) Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY)iii) National Crop Insurance Programme (NCIP)iv) Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana (PMKSY)

The above Schemes/Missions are under continuous implementation throughout the country including the State of West Bengal during the 12th Plan.
