(a) whether the Government is contemplating to produce indigenous hybrid seeds of foreign hybrid seeds variety in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has signed any agreement with the World Trade Organisation for use of foreign hybrid seeds variety in the agricultural sector; and

(d) if so, the details thereof along with the likely impact of the agreement on the production of indigenous variety of seeds?

(a) & (b): Under the New Policy on Seed Development, 1988 and amendments thereon, the seeds of cereals, coarse cereals, pulses, oilseeds and fodder crops are allowed for import for a period of two years subject to evaluation of their performance in Multi-Location Trial, and, also with the condition that within this period, the importer has to import the parental line seeds/nucleus seeds for further production in India.
