(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government proposes to conduct a study to find out the soil health in the flood regions of all major rivers in the country; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): The National Green Tribunal (NGT) vide its order dated 13.01.2015 in O.A. No.6 of 2012 has directed that no authority shall permit and no person shall carryout, any edible crops/fodder cultivation on the Flood Plain of Yamuna River and that this direction shall strictly be adhered to till Yamuna is made pollution free and is restored to its natural wholesomeness.
