MONITORING DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES IN NER

Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has developed/proposes to develop any mechanism to monitor the different schemes being run for the development of North Eastern States; and

(b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

The Minister of State (Independent Charge) of the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (Dr. Jitendra Singh)

(a) & (b): One of the mandated roles of the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (M/o DoNER) is monitoring of developmental schemes and projects in NER taken up under the earmarked fund by the various sectoral ministries. As a part of the mandated role, the Ministry is closely monitoring the progress of schematic fund release to the states and utilisation, day to day status of which is available in the website of Ministry of Finance. Based on the analysis State Governments of North East are advised to review schematic performance of line departments at a higher level wherever improvement is needed. Concerned ministries are also requested to have a close review for improving performance.

As regards monitoring of major infrastructure projects, such as road, rail, air, inland water transport, telecom, power etc. implemented by various ministries, M/o DoNER has been organising inter-ministerial consultations to expedite implementation by removing hurdles wherein state Governments of North East are involved.
