(a) & (b): During the year 2014-15, Government of Jammu and Kashmir had requested for additional foodgrains at subsidized rates for flood affected people of the State. Based on the request Govt. of India allocated 127346 tons of foodgrains to the State at Minimum Support Price (MSP)/MSP derived prices for wheat and rice respectively in accordance with the existing policy.
