(a) to (c) Animal Husbandry is a State subject and as per the allocation of business rules the Department of Animal Husbandry Dairying and Fisheries in the Ministry of Agriculture has not been allotted mandate to take up animal welfare issues and this is the mandate of Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI) in the Ministry of Environment and Forests. In order to compliment and supplement the efforts made by the States, the Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI) is implementing Central Sector Schemes having provisions for shelter houses and welfare of stray and unproductive animals including cattle.
