- (a) The Government of India has set up seven Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs) having their headquarters at Patiala in Punjab, Udaipur in Rajasthan, Allahabad in Uttar Pradesh, Kolkata in West Bengal, Dimapur in Nagaland, Nagpur in Maharashtra and Thanjavur in Tamil Nadu.
