- (a) & (b) The following programmes are being implemented by this Ministry for the betterment of minority communities all over India including Rajasthan:
- I. Educational Empowerment Schemes
- a) Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme
- b) Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme
- c) Merit-cum-Means Based Scholarship Scheme:
- d) Free Coaching & Allied Scheme
- e) Maulana Azad National Fellowship
- f) Padho Pardesh: Interest Subsidy for overseas studies
- g) Support to minority candidates clearing Prelims conducted by Union Public Service Commission (UPSC)/ Staff Selection Commission (SSC), State Public Service Commission (PSC) etc.
- II. Women Empowerment Scheme
- a) Nai Roshni Leadership Development of Minority Women
- III. Economic Empowerment Schemes
- a) Term Loans, Micro-Finance and Educational Loans at concessional rates by National Minorities Development and Finance Corporation (NMDFC).
- b) Mahila Samriddhi Yojana training in a vocational trade linked with Micro-Finance among minority Women by NMDFC.
- c) Seekho aur Kamao Upgrading the skills of Minority Youth which can earn them suitable employment or enable them to go for self-employment.
- IV. Area Development Programme
- a) Multi-sectoral Development Programme To address the development deficits by creating socio-economic infras- tructure and providing basic amenities.
- V. Vulnerable Minority Community Development
- a) Jiyo Parsi Focuses on advocacy/outreach programmes to generate awareness among Parsi population for lineage enhancement.
