(a),(b)&(c) During the last five years CSIR has completed projects undertaken during Eleventh Five Year Plan period and a few spilled-over projects of Tenth Five Year Plan. A list of such projects is given in Annexure-I. The Annexure-II provides information on the projects undertaken during the Twelfth Five Year Plan.

Deliverables of the projects completed during the afore-mentioned period were of varying nature and included knowledgebase generation in the field of Biological Sciences, Chemical Sciences, Engineering Sciences, Information Sciences, and Physical Sciences; enhancement of core competency; generation of intellectual property, generating pool of trained S&T Human Resource in aforesaid areas; benefits accruing to the common people etc. Some of the significant achievements are included in Annexure-Ill.
