- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e) No major encroachment on National Highways has come to the notice of the Government. However, cases of temporary encroachments/squatters on National Highways came to the notice of authorities and those have been removed immediately, as per the provisions of the Control of National Highways (Land and Traffic) Act, 2002.
