**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Rajasthan Government has demanded Rs. 7500 crore from the Union Government for the repairing and maintenance of highways and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether an amount of Rs. 1500 crores has been sanctioned by the Government for National Highway project to the State of Rajasthan;
- (c) if so, the details thereof including the demand received from Rajasthan Government for NH projects;
- (d) the details of the projects completed and projects not yet started due to the land acquisition issues; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to establish coordination between the Government of Rajasthan and the NHAI with a view to complete the projects in a time bound manner?

**Answer**
