- (a) the details with regard to internationally accepted norms for the `colour scheme` along with the norms adopted in India;
- (b) whether the Government has any proposal/plan to use `Cat's Eye` or `Solar Road Marker` to stop/prevent the road accidents on national highways; and
- (c) if so, the details and status thereof?

**Answer**

(a) The road signages are used on NHs in accordance with the First Schedule of Motor Vehicles Act 1988. The signs and its colours have uniformity. The road signs adopted in this code are in harmony with protocol on road signs and signals of United Nations Conference on Road Motor Transport 1949 and Vienna Convention on Road Signs and Signals, 1968.

(b) & (c) Cat's Eyes are being provided especially on intersections for the safety of road users .
