(a) whether the University Grants Commission (UGC) has issued any directive to all universities and colleges to ensure that each student plant a tree in their campuses under the scheme, `one student-one tree`; and

(a) & (b): The University Grants Commission(UGC) has written to Vice Chancellor of all Universities to compulsorily implement Six Months Core Module Syllabus on Environmental Studies for under-graduate courses in all branches of higher education and to create awareness among the student population for preservation of environment. The UGC has also informed universities that a step further to this is the concept of `One Student One Tree` for which the students will be involved in nurtu- ring a tree for preservation of environment. The UGC has requested Uni- versities to avail the services of National Service Scheme (NSS) etc. to ensure that at least one tree is planted by a student during his/her stay in the university/affiliated colleges. Free saplings to students for plan- tation and conducting of a 'Special Plantation Drive', along with distri- bution of publicity material on environmental preservation, has also been advised to Universities by the UGC to make their campuses green.
