(a) and (b): The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has the following mechanisms to maintain secrecy of question papers of class 10th and 12th-

The question papers are stored in the secured places.

The question papers are handed over to the authorized official on the same day before few hours of start of the examination.

The question papers are packed in special envelopes.

At Examination Centre, question papers are opened by the Centre Superintendent in the presence of four invigilators including outside invigilators from the centre school.

The above process is applicable for all CBSE examinations in the country.
