(a)to(c): The details of Thermal Power Plants (TPPs) (coal, lignite & gas based) located in Rajasthan are as under:

In order to meet the shortfall in domestic coal availability, power utilities including Rajasthan Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Ltd. (RVUNL) have been advised by the Ministry of Power to import coal for their power plants. Accordingly, RVUNL was advised to import 0.5 Million Tonne (MT) of coal. During the period April- June, 2014, RVUNL has imported 0.217 MT against prorata target of 0.13 MT.
