- (e) the time by which it is likely to be implemented?

(a) to (e): Education, being a subject in the concurrent List of the Constitution, and the majority of schools being under the jurisdiction of the State Governments, it is for the respective State/UT Governments to take appropriate steps in the matter. However, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) being a National Board has introduced the National Cadet Corps (NCC) as an optional subject in class IX and X (Certificate A) and elective subject for class XI and XII (Certificate B) from academic session 2013-14 in its affiliated schools.
