- (a) whether the Government has received huge investment proposals for telecommunication and information technology sector under "Make in India" initiative for manufacturing of telecom equipments including mobile handsets; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b) 63 proposals amounting to investments of Rs 20, 825 crores have been received under M-SIPS for manufacturing of electronic hardware. These include 4 proposals for manufacturing of telecom equipments including mobile handsets with proposed investments of Rs.2295 crores. In addition, 5 proposals amounting to investments of Rs.288 crore of EMS companies are also received where interalia telecom, mobile equipments and IT Handsets are also manufactured.
