- (b) A pilot Road Asset Management System is being developed for National Highways.
- (c) Yes, Madam, under WBTA-7980-IN.
- (d) It will help build a sustainable Road Asset Management System (RAMS) for India's National Highways by having a comprehensive Road Database for NHs supported by analytical tools to be used by both NHA and MoRTH. The RAMS, equipped with GIS capacity will provide information to road administrators and users on various attributes of the road network.
