(a) to (c) The upgradation of State roads to National Highways (NHs) and development thereof, including the NHs in Chhattisgarh is a continuous process and taken up from time to time depending upon requirement of connectivity, inter-se-priority and availability of funds. Length of about 742 km of State Roads has been declared as NH in Chhattisgarh during last two years.
