(a) to (c) To have coordination with all concerned for evolving an appropriate skill development framework and removal of disconnect between the demand for and supply of skilled manpower through vocational and technical training, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has been constituted by the Government. As per Cabinet Secretariat Office Memorandum No. 1/21/9/2014- Cab dated 16th April, 2015, the two verticals i.e. Deputy Director General (Training) and Deputy Director General (Apprenticeship Training) looking after the work related to Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and apprenticeship training, etc., has been transferred from Ministry of Labour and Employment to Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship.
