Government has accepted the recommendations of the 14th Finance

- (b) Commission to enhance share of states in the divisible pool of central taxes & duties from 32 per cent to 42 percent.
- (c) The total amount of 523958.24 crore has been allocated to the States in the Budget Estimates for the fiscal year 2015-16.
- (d) The Government has also accepted the horizontal distribution of total devolution to States as recommended by the 14th Finance Commission and
- (e.) accordingly allocation to the States would be made in the award period (2015-20).
