ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW IITS IIMS

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has established new Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) and Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) and if so, the progress/status of various infrastructural development works including new campuses against timeline fixed for the purpose, Institute- wise;

(b) whether fresh proposals have been received from the various States for setting up of new IITs/IIMs, if so, the details thereof, State-wise and the action taken by the Government thereon;

(c) whether the locations for the proposed institutes have been identified and if so, the details thereof; State-wise; and

(d) the time by which these institutes are likely to be established?

Answer

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF THE LOR SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 415 REGARDING 'ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW IITS/IIMS' RAISED BY SHRI MALYADRI SRIRAM AND DR C.GOPALAKRISHNAN.

(a) : Of the 16 Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) functioning in the country at present, eight new IITs were set up pursuant to being approved by the Union Cabinet on 17.07.2008. These new IITs were proposed to be set up over a period of six years at a total cost of Rs.6080 Crore. However, due to delayed handing over of land by the State Governments, shifting of these new IITs to their permanent campuses has been delayed. Details are as under:-

As regards, Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs), there are 13 IIMs presently functioning in the country, of which seven new IIMs at Shillong, Rohtak, Raipur, Ranchi, Trichy, Udaipur and Kashipur were set up during XI Plan Period.

(b) to (d): List showing requests received for establishment of an Indian Institute of Technology in their State from various VIPs including Chief Minister of the State is enclosed at Annexure-I. Proposals from State Governments of Telengana, Tripura, Assam and Goa have been received for setting up of new IIMs.

In pursuance of the Budget Announcement in July, 2014, it has been decided to set up five new IITs in Jammu (J & K), Chhattisgarh

(Durg/Bhilai), Andhra Pradesh (Tirupati), Goa (Pernem) and Kerala (Palakkad) and six new IIMs in Gaya (Bihar), Odisha (Bhubaneshwar), Maharashtra (Nagpur), Punjab (Amritsar), Himachal Pradesh (Sirmaur) and Andhra Pradesh (Vishakhapatnam). The IITs and IIMs whose temporary campuses have been identified and approved will commence their academic session from the year 2015-16. Establishment of the permanent campus of these institutes depends on allotment of land, free of legal encumbrances, by the concerned State Governments. In the case of IITs, the State Governments are to identify suitable land measuring about 500-600 acres which is to be allotted free of cost, free of legal encumbrances at a location having necessary infrastructure such as road, rail and air connectivity, physical infrastructure and basic-facilities for setting up of the IITs.
