- (a) and (b): The syllabi for the schools affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) are framed in accordance with the National Curriculum Framework (NCF), 2005 which inter-alia advocates the inclusion of the teachings of saints and legendary figures in the school curriculum. The ideas of eminent social reformers and freedom fighters are amply reflected in the textbooks taught in CBSE affiliated schools. Recently, CBSE approved a course on Traditional Knowledge Practice of India, which Reaches the students about our country's ancient wisdom.
