Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has assessed the performance of the Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) system of education in the country and if so, the details and find ings thereof;
- (b) whether there have been complaints about failure of the CCE System and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government plans to review this system and bring about changes in the same;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the action taken/likely to be taken by the Government to make education stressless and enjoyable?

Answer

- (a) to (d): The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) from time to time conducts surveys for the feedback on Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE). The findings of such surveys emphasize the revision of the existing scheme of CCE. CBSE has also received sporadic complaints about CCE such as inculcation of non-serious attitude, lack of motivation in children, increase of teacher work load and inaccurate assessments by the CBSE affiliated schools.
- (e). The CBSE from time to time takes steps to reduce examination stress among students such as introduction of Grading system, provision of additional time and counseling services.
