- (a) whether the Southern Indian Mills Association (SIMA) members have requested the Union Government to offer subsidy for projects that were started during the `blackout period` when the Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme was suspended between June, 2010 and April, 2011;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the projects to the tune of Rs.24,000 crore of mills mostly from Tamil Nadu and unified Andhra Pradesh have been classified as blackout period cases; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the response of the Government thereon?
