(a) & (b) Government of India has been in discussion with Government of Bangladesh for an Agreement on sharing of common rivers including Teesta on an equitable and fair basis. During the visit of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India to Dhaka, Bangladesh in September 2011, both the Prime Ministers, welcomed the progress and directed the concerned officials to conclude the agreement at the earliest. Subsequently, discussions have also been held at various bilateral fora from time to time with Bangladesh in this regard.

Union Government has also discussed all points involved therein with the Government of West Bengal at appropriate levels to arrive at an agreement on Teesta on a fair and equitable basis, which is acceptable to all the parties concerned with which protects the interests of all stake holders.
