- (a):India is the worlds 2nd largest exporter of cotton.
- (b) to (d):Cotton exports are currently under Open General License subject to a prescribed procedure of registration. There is no additional restriction on export of cotton.
- (e):The Ministry of Finance, Department of Revenue vide Notification No. 98/2013 CUSTOMS (N.T.) dated 14.09.2013 has notified duty drawback of 1% for Export of Cotton.
