(b) whether there is any financial liability to the Government of India for paying incentive to these agents;

(c) if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government proposes to withdraw the incentive paid to these agents and whether the Government has received any representation from the State Government of Kerala in this regard; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government thereon?

(a) Madam, 195296 agents have been appointed under the Mahila Pradhan Kshetriya Bachat Yojana (MPKBY) and Rs 1191 crores have been paid as commission to them for the financial year 2014-15.

(b) There is no financial liability to Government of India for paying incentive to MPKBY agents by the State Government over and above the commission payable to them by Central Government.

(c) Does not arise in view of (b) above.

(d) No Madam. However, the incentive, if any paid by State/Union Territory Government shall be reduced from the commission paid by the Central Government and the Government has not received any representation from the State Government of Kerala in this regard.
