- (a) whether the Administrative Reforms Commission has recommended to set up institutes for imparting training to officers at regional level apart from providing training at the top level; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the progress made in this regard, so far?

- (a): Yes Madam,
- (b): The Central Government supports setting up of Regional/District level training centre through State Administrative Training Institutes (ATIs) by providing financial assistance for augmentation of capacity of the training institutions in the form of hardware, software, course- ware, networking of training institution and training ware under the Plan Scheme of `Training for AH`. These institutes are also encouraged and supported for developing case studies, e-learning packages, training films, organizing workshop/seminars etc.

As part of implementation of the recommendation of the 2nd ARC, the allocation under the plan scheme of Training for All` was raised to Rs.26 crores in the financial year 2012-13 with an overall outlay of Rs.127.63 crores for the 12th Five year plan as a whole in comparison to Rs. 18 crores in the terminal year of the 11th Five Year Plan.
