(a):No, Madam. However, talks are on between Indian Oil Corporation and Nepal Oil Corporation for setting up a Petroleum product pipeline from Raxaul in India to Amlekhganj in Nepal.

(b) and (c): Does not apply.

(d); Bulk LPG to Nepal Oil Corporation is dispatched through road tankers positioned by private bottJera of Nepal Oil Corporation at Indian Oil Corporation Ltd.(IOCL)Reftneries. Supplies to Nepal during last three years have been as under:

Year 2011-12 2012-13 2013-14 2014-15(till Feb`15 Supplies 174.4 200.5 227.3 225.9 to Nepal (TMT)

(e); In case of enhanced demand from Nepal, supplies will be augmented once the Paradip Refinery is commissioned.
