- (b) the number of such PSUs making profit / loss, unit-wise;
- (c) the reasons for their sickness, if any;
- (d) the total number of workers in the sick PSUs, unit-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for the revival of the sick psus?

(a) & (b): Details of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), as per Registered Offices, located in the State of Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat alongwith profit/loss reported by these CPSEs in the year 2013-14, as per Public Enterprises Survey 2013-14 laid in the Parliament on 26.02.2015, are given in the Table below.

(C) & (d): Out Of the five CPSEs mentioned in the Table above, NEPA Ltd. is a sick CPSE and is registered with Board for industrial and Financial Reconstruction (BIFR) as it has negative net worth, of RS. (-)16.32 crore. The reasons for SickneSS Of NEPA Ltd. included, inter-alia, high cost of production and old plant & machinery. There were S21 employees on the rolls Of NEPA Ltd. SS On 31.3.2014.

(e). The administrative Ministry/Department takes steps on case to case basis for revival of sick CPSEe under its jurisdiction. The Government approved a revival package on 06.09.2012 of Rs.669.12 crore consisting of cash assistance of Rs.234.18 crore and non-cash assistance of Rs.634.94 crore for revival of NEPA Ltd.
