EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN PSUS

**Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether employment opportunities in Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) has shown a decline during the last five years;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of PSUs functioning in Jharkhand and their present employment situation; and
- (d) the details of the steps taken/ proposed to be taken by the Government for increasing the job opportunities in PSUS in the country, particularly in Jharkhand?

**Answer**

(a) & (b); As per Public Enterprises Survey, 2012-13, the total number of employees in Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) during last five years were as follows:

Year Employees in CPSEs  
(in Lakhs)

2012-13	14.04
2011-12	14.50
2010-11	14.40
2009-10	14.90
2008-09	15.33

In addition to above CPSEs also employ Contractual / Casual Workers. CPSEs also provide indirect employment to number of persons.

(c) & (d): As per Public Enterprises Survey, 2012-13, as on 31.3.2013, there were 10 CPSEs having their registered office in Jharkhand. These CPSEs had 1,27,452 employees. Management of CPSEs in consultation with their administrative Ministry / Department, if required, are authorized to take decisions in respect of recruitment of their employees.
