- (b) Recently new technologies have been adopted, such as Relational Database Management System (RDBMS) for data processing for Socio-economic Surveys and Web Portals for data collection, validation for Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) and compilation of Consumer Price Indices (CPI). Training Programmes for building the capacity of the personnel and keeping them abreast of the international practices are also organised.
