- (a): The National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) conducts large scale nation-wide sample surveys on various socio-economic subjects. The broad subject areas covered in these surveys include inter-alia Household Consumer Expenditure, Employment and Unemployment, Social Consumption, Unorganised Manufacturing, Services Sectors, Land and Livestock Holdings, Debt and Investment, etc.
- (b): Depending upon the subject coverage of the surveys, primary data on socio-economic subjects are collected from statistically selected households/enterprises all over the country.
- (c): A Statement showing some key indicators released based on the surveys conducted by NSSO during last three years is enclosed.
