- (a)The scheme "Intensive Dairy Development Programme" (IDDP) was implemented in the country from 1993-94 to 2013-14. IDDP scheme has been discontinued from 2014-15 and has been subsumed along with its objectives and targets under the new Scheme, National Programme for Bovine Breeding and Dairy Development (NPBBDD) for implementation during the 12th Five Year Plan.
- (b) The statement indicating State-wise approved outlay, total fund released under IDDP since inception upto 30.6.2015 is Annexed.
