(a): The details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred under Road Requirement Plan (RRP-I) in 34 LWE affected districts of 8 States during the years 2014-15 and 2015-16 are as under:

(b): State-wise details of projects undertaken under RRP-I and expenditure incurred thereon (as on 30.06.2015) are given below:

Besides, the Ministry of Rural Development has also sanctioned 30,204 road works comprising 1,20,627 km length of roads in 10 LWE affected States i.e. Andhra Pradesh (1,574), Bihar (5,397), Chhattisgarh (3,378), Jharkhand (3,675), Madhya Pradesh (4,137), Maharashtra (780), Odisha (7,422), Telangana (1,611), Uttar Pradesh (726) and West Bengal (1,504) under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) initiated from December, 2000. Of the total sanctioned length (1,20,627 km); 87,462 km of roads have been completed upto 15.07.2015 with an expenditure of Rs. 28,514.55 crore.
