- (c) whether the Government has also any proposal to approve Resident Identity Card (RIC) Project as a final step in the NPR process and if so, the estimated number of RIC likely to be issued to persons above 18 years of age;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to issue a Smart Card by integrating Aadhaar number with Photo Election Card, Passport, Pan Card, Driving Licence, Ration Card etc. and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the corrective steps taken to avoid duplication of efforts between different agencies of the Government as expenditure from the Public Exchequer?

## **Answer**

- (a): Yes, Madam.
- (b): The Government has decided to update the National Population Register (NPR) and seed the Aadhaar number in NPR database at an estimated cost of Rs. 951.35 crore. The field work would be completed by March 2016. This updated NPR database along with Aadhaar Number would become the mother database and can be used by various government departments for selection of beneficiaries under their respective schemes.
