(a): The State of Telangana came into existence with effect from 02nd June 2014. The Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act, 2014 has made lot of provisions for overall development of the successor States of Andhra Pradesh as well as Telangana . Various Ministries have to implement the projects as listed out in schedule -13 as well as different Sections of the2/

Andhra Pradesh Re-organisation Act. Being the nodal Ministry implementation of these provisions of the Act is being closely monitored by the Ministry of Home Affairs.

(b): No, Madam.

(C)& (D): Yes, Madam .As per section 8 (1) of the Act, for the purposes of administration of the common capital area of Hyderabad for both the States , the Governor shall have special responsibility for the security of life ,Liberty and Property of all those who reside in such area. Further, section 8(2) extends the responsibility of the Governor of Andhra Pradesh & Telangana to matters such as law and order, internal security and security of vital installations, and management and allocation of Government building in the common capital area.
