(a) Yes, Madam.

(b) The details of inspections carried out by respective metro company officials in the metro stations of the three operational metro rail being implemented on 50:50 joint venture between Government of

India (Gol) and the concerned State Governments i.e. Delhi, Bangalore and Chennai is given in Annexure-I.

(c) The inspections carried out are related to the deficiencies regarding station's upkeep and include the following:

I. Civil installations / structures i.e. leakage, blockage of drains, damage to structure & equipment, water accumulation, false ceiling / flooring, glasses, toilets, etc.

II. Electrical installations / equipment i.e. lighting, air-conditioners, power points, fire alarm Control Panel, fans, Rolling Shutters.

III. Signalling & Telecom installation / equipments such as AFC Gates, Ticket Office Machines, Passenger Information Display / Announcement System, etc.

IV. Cleanliness of the station premises.

Deficiencies are attended/rectified expeditiously through instructions at site, guidelines and maintenance procedures with follow up inspections by the concerned officials.
