(a) to (e) Water being a State subject, water resources projects are planned and implemented by the respective State Governments. State Governments generally formulate and implement project wise Rehabilitation and Resettlement plan. Union Government has issued the National Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy 2007 (NRRP-2007) and "the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013" for implementation of Rehabilitation and Resettlement action plan in respect of Project Affected Families. However, compensation for project affected people are decided by the project authorities as per existing Rehabilitation and Resettlement policy of Centre/State whichever is more beneficial.
