Implementation of IPDS

- (a) whether the Government has implemented the Integrated Processing Development Scheme (IPDS) to address the environmental issues faced by the textile processing units in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has made any significant process in the implementation of IPDS; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (d): Yes Madam, the government has introduced Integrated Processing Development Scheme (IPDS) with an outlay of Rs.500 crore during the 12th Five Year Plan to address the environmental issues faced by the textile processing units. The Government of India provides assistance up to 50% of the project cost with a ceiling of Rs.75 cr. towards technology components for Common Effluent Treat Plant (CETP). The projects require clearance from the respective State Pollution Control Board and commitment from the concerned State Government to contribute 25% of the project cost. One project for upgradation of 18 MLD CETP into Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) at Balotra Rajasthan has been approved under the scheme.
