- (a) whether the Union Government is considering to establish any Textile Special Economic Zone in Nasik district, Maharashtra due to the proximate to the textile manufacturing hub of Surat of Gujarat;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Union Government in this regard;
- (c) whether the Union Government has received any request/proposal from any State Governments in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Union Government thereon?

(a) to (d): Setting up of Special Economic Zones (SEZ) is dealt by Ministry of Commerce and it has been ascertained that no proposal for setting up any Special Economic Zone in Nasik district of Maharashtra has been received by them. Ministry of Textiles has been extending assistance for setting up of Integrated Textile Parks. A total of 70 parks are sanctioned so far under the scheme of which 16 are located in Maharashtra. The list of parks in Maharashtra is enclosed.
