- (c) Yes, Madam. Fee will be collected electronically on the existing fee plaza.
- (d) & (e) Yes, Madam. Government has decided to implement Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) system on pan India basis by 2015. In this system a pre-paid electronic tag "FASTag" will be fixed on the wind screen of the vehicle. Once fitted with "FASTag" vehicle will move seamlessly throughout all fee plazas on National Highways across the country and fee amount will be deducted automatically. Interoperable ETC system is already operational on Delhi Mumbai arm of Golden Quadrilateral. Once implemented, it will help in reducing congestion at the Toll Plazas.
