(a) to (c) This Ministry is mainly responsible for development of National Highways. During the last three years about 545 km of National Highways are constructed in border areas. The State wise list of construction is annexed. Funds are allocated State wise for development of National Highways including those in border area and not project wise. Development of National Highways in border areas is a continuous process and carried out as per availability of funds and inter-se priority.
