Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has set up 'One Stop Crisis Centre' to assist and support women affected by violence in all the districts of the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise along with number of women benefited from such centres since inception, State/UT-wise:
- (b) the funds including Nirbhaya Fund provided by the Government to each State/UT for setting up of such centres in the country along with its utilisations reported by each State/UT so far;
- (c) whether some discrepancies/scarcity of funds have been reported/come to the notice of the Government in the functioning of such centres and if so, the details thereof along with remedial measures taken/being taken by the Government in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government has integrated/proposes to integrate these centres with other helplines and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) The other corrective steps taken/being taken by the Government for setting up of such centres in each district and to ensure safety and security of women in the country?

- (a): The Scheme for One Stop Centre for Women affected by violence with total project cost of Rs. 18.58 crore has also been approved to be funded under Nirbhaya Fund. The scheme is being implemented since 1st April 2015. The Scheme envisages establishment of 1 One Stop Centre in each State/UT in the first phase.
- (b): All the States/UTs have been requested to submit the proposals in order to release funds. So far, the funds released to State/UTs for setting up One Stop Centres in the country are as under.
