- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) As per the announcement made by the Honble Prime Minister in August 2008, Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Petroleum Technology (RGIPT) has been mandated to open a Centre in Assam. For establishing the Centre, Government of Assam has allotted land in Sivasagar where the Institutes own campus is currently under construction.
- (c) The details of the fund approved for RGIPT Assam Centre are as follows:-

The fund for the RGIPT Assam Centre has been allocated by way of grant from Oil Industry Development Board and contribution by Oil PSUs under the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas.
